## ARMY OF C OF C STUDENTS TO CLEAN DOWNTOWN FEB. 11 New Adopt-A-Street Program Targets 15 City Streets

A cleaner downtown Charleston is the goal of more than 600 College of Charleston students participating in an ambitious new Adopt-A-Street program.

On the morning of Saturday, Feb. 11, 15 downtown streets will be stormed by students bearing brooms, rakes and trash bags. The initiative is being organized by the school's Student Government Association. Eighteen school organizations have signed on, with more groups and community volunteers being sought.

"CofC students don't take the beauty and history of downtown Charleston for granted," said Holly Holloway, the SGA's president. "We want to do our part to maintain and spruce up this special environment we get to live in during our college lives here. We've timed this neighborhood cleaning to be the weekend before the big Southeastern Wildlife Exhibition so downtown will look really good for the thousands of SEWE visitors."

Streets to be swept Saturday will be: Calhoun, Coming, King, Vanderhorst, Smith, Liberty, Smith, Hassle, Warren, St. Philip, Pitt, Bull, Montagu, Meeting and Wentworth.

Participating C of C groups include the Greek Affairs Council (consisting of 12 fraternities and sororities), the Resident Halls Association, Student Senate, Criminal Justice Club, ROTC, the Public Relations Student Society of America, and the Women's Caucus.
